ORDER

10.08.2022

A complaint was received from Smt. Dipa Deb (Roy) of Kalkalia under Sidhai P.S wherein allegation was made that on 29.12.2021 her two brothers trespassed into her house and assaulted her and thereafter, she was treated at Mohanpur CHC. It also mentioned that she made a written complaint to Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S but no action was taken against the accused persons. Her complaint also mentioned that on 09.04.2022 the accused persons (her brothers) had also taken away her domestic animal (cow) which was her means of livelihood. Thereafter, she again lodged a complaint to Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S but no action was taken. As a result, she made a complaint to Superintendent of Police, West Tripura on 26.04.2022.

2. The Commission took cognizance of the complaint of Smt. Dipa Deb (Roy) and accordingly, notice was issued to Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S seeking his reply. The Commission received reply dated 23.05.2022 of Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S and also a report from AIGP (Crime) vide letter dated 20.05.2022. The following aspects emerged from the reply of Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S and the report of AIGP (Crime)-

- (i) There was a land dispute between the complainant and her brothers.
- (ii) On 09.04.2022 her (complainant) domestic animal (cow) entered into the field of her brothers and as a result, the cow were detained but later returned after amicably settlement of dispute between two sides.
- (iii) Smt. Dipa Deb (Roy) had made a complaint about the theft of cows, house trespass out of anger. However, after having resolved the matter with her brothers there is no complaint.


3. After taking into consideration the report and the reply received from AIGP (Crime) and Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S, the Commission decided to obtain response / comments of the complainant on the reply / report of the said officials. The Commission received communication dated 21.06.2022 from the complainant in which she mentioned that her problem have been resolved by amicably settlement with her brothers with the intervention of Police and as such now there is no complaint / grievance against them (Police).




4. After taking into consideration the complaint of Smt. Dipa Deb (Roy), report of AIGP (Crime), reply of Officer-in-Charge, Sidhai P.S and the response of the complainant on the report / replies of Police officials, we are of the view that since the complainant is not having any grievance against the Police, therefore, no purpose would serve by proceeding further with the enquiry. Moreover, the information as available with the Commission also does not reveal any such fact which may attract charge of '*serious misconduct*' against any Police officer as defined in the sub-section (2) of section-66 of Tripura Police Act, 2007.

5. The matter is accordingly, closed.
