ORDER

Dt. 16.08.2022

A complaint dt. 30.04.2022 was received from one Smt. Pallabi Sinha with address of Vill & P.O.- Fultali, Kailashahar, Unakoti, Triura. The said petition (complaint) though gave detailed address and contact telephone number of the complainant, but was unauthenticated (unsigned). Complaint was about inaction on the part of Kailashahar P.S. in connection with an incident of assault which reportedly occurred on 29.04.2022. As it appeared from the complaint, she had approached Kailashahar P.S. on the same day in connection with the incident. The complainant also enclosed copy of one newspaper clipping with photographs of people having grievous injuries. As the complaint was not authenticated (was unsigned) by the complainant, the Commission directed its official to contact the complainant over telephone and obtain an authenticated copy so that further steps can be taken immediately.

2. Accordingly, husband of the complainant could be contacted on 5/5/2022 and he was requested to arrange for sending an authenticated


copy of the complaint. As no authenticated copy was received, another communication was made on 30/5/2022 over telephone requesting the complainant to send an authenticated copy of the complaint. However, despite these two communications, the complainant did not send any authenticated copy.

3. Considering the nature of complaint, the Commission decided to provide one more opportunity to the complainant to send an authenticated copy of the complaint and accordingly, a written communication was sent on 20.07.2022 at the declared address. Finally, we have received a Xerox copy of the written communication dt. 29.07.2022, signed by the complainant, stating that FIR has been registered in Kailashahar P.S. on 01/05/2022. In her written communication, she has also stated the followings:-

"....., I am satisfied and want to withdraw my complaint against Kailashahar P.S."

4. From the details available with the Commission, it appears that the incident occurred on 29.04.2022 and as per communication of Smt. Pallabi Sinha, FIR has been registered on 01/05/2022 under various provisions of IPC. Under the circumstances, we do not find any reason to continue further with the inquiry, specifically, when FIR has been filed and moreover, complainant appears to be satisfied with the steps of the police. The case is accordingly closed.

5. Send a copy of the order to Secretary, Home Department, DGP and the complainant.
